Dear Ms. Lindberg:

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (commission) has received your tariff filing for a surcharge. To help us understand your current situation, please answer the following questions:

1. How many customers are currently served by Cristalina? Information at the Department of Health indicates there are 85 customers, as do your last two annual reports on file with the commission. However, the filing spreadsheet for the Public Works Board shows 84 customers. Please provide the correct number of customers.
2. What is the approved interest rate for the loan?
3. Please provide a copy of the SRF loan application. A scanned, electronic copy is preferred.
4. Please provide a balance sheet as of 12/31/2008.
5. Please provide an income statement for 2008.
6. Review of annual reports filed by Cristalina with the commission show a large increase in Customer Accounts Receivable (from \$15,793 in 2005, as originally filed, to \$104,535 as filed in the 2006 report.) Amounts shown in this item continued to increase (2006, \$121,094; 2007, \$130,016.) Please explain the reasons for this change in the company's Customer Accounts Receivable.

Commission staff is arranging for this filing to be on the open meeting agenda of May 28, 2009 for recommendations and action. Data requests responses, discussions, and analysis need to be completed before May 15, so please return all responses by April 28, 2009, for staff to prepare materials for the meetings and avoid any delays in the effective date of this filing.
