Dear Ms. Rathbun:

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) has received your filing for changes to your tariff for your irrigation business. To help us understand your current situation, please answer the following questions:

1. Please describe the circumstances behind the sale of the RDO Gator. In the prior rate case this item was shown on the SVWW balance sheet but it appears that Candy Mountain Farms owned the Gator.
2. Review of your company's profit and loss statement for the 2008 test year shows an expense called "Capital Expense for Review" for \$15,747.00. Please provide a schedule of these expenses showing dates, items purchased, from whom purchased, and the amounts paid.
3. Purchased power expenses include bills for Meter 42310, serving 17115 S. Grandview Lane. Are there separate meters for the water system facilities and the personal residence located on that parcel or are the invoices from Benton PUD for Meter 42310 for both the domestic pump house and the residence?
4. Domestic Water Use Data—Please provide an electronic listing of use amounts
5. SVWW's Profit & Loss Detail shows \$2157.63 in gravel purchases on 3/20/08. To what expense category was this purchase posted?
6. Rent expense appears on the profit and loss statement two different times. Please explain.
7. The company's 12/31/08 balance sheet lists fixed assets of \$64,024 less accumulated depreciation of \$35,977. Please provide a schedule showing each asset along with its purchase price, accumulated depreciation balance, salvage value (if any), and the depreciable life assigned by SVWW.
8. Please provide water use data for the domestic customers in an electronic format for staff analysis. (QuickBooks does have an export to Excel function.) Please advise staff if this is not possible or if the data already exists in some other electronic format.

Commission staff is arranging for this filing to be on the open meeting agenda of June 25, 2009. Data request responses, discussions, and analysis need to be completed before June 10, 2009 for staff to prepare materials for the meetings and to avoid any delays in the effective date of this filing. **Please respond to these questions by May 26, 2009.** I look forward to continued work with you.
