Dear Ms. Rathbun:

The Washington Utilities and Transportation Commission (Commission) has received your filing for changes to your tariff for your irrigation business. To help us understand your current situation, please answer the following questions:

1. What is the company's accounting basis, cash or accrual? Your 2006 annual report to the commission states cash, the 2007 report does not say which basis, and the packet of information provided with your filing states all information is prepared on an accrual basis.
2. The 2008 profit and loss statement includes a "Utilities-Other" for \$1645.37. Please identify what this expense is for and to whom it was paid.
3. Please describe the telemetry system being installed.
4. The 2008 profit and loss statement includes a line item for "Well Telemetry" with an associated expense of \$5,148.76. Most construction expenses related to the telemetry system appear to be in the Supplies expense line item. What is the "Well Telemetry" expense for?
5. Are all legal expenses incurred for the year associated with SVWW's water rights issues?
6. Is the TAK Technologies Quikwater Rural software solely an accounting package or is it integrated into SVWW's telemetry system?

Commission staff is arranging for this filing to be on the open meeting agenda of June 25, 2009. Data request responses, discussions, and analysis need to be completed before June 10, 2009 for staff to prepare materials for the meetings and to avoid any delays in the effective date of this filing. **Please respond to these questions by May 28, 2009.** I look forward to continued work with you.
